# The Scoop

#### **Intergroup Elections**

Qualifications are as follows:

#### Chair

- \*\* Four (4) years continuous sobriety.
- \*\* Experience as a Board member at A.A. group or of an AA service group.

#### Co-Chair

- \*\* Four (4) years continuous sobriety.
- \*\* Commitment to assuming Chairperson position after current tenure, if nominated.

#### Secretary

\*\* One (1) year continuous sobriety.

\*\* Ability to take accurate notes and transcribe them to typewritten form.

#### **Treasurer**

- \*\* Three (3) years continuous sobriety.
- \*\* Basic comprehension of accounting principles and acceptable standards.
- \*\* May not be related to nor cohabitate with the Office Manager.

#### **Members At Large**

- \*\* Fifteen (15) years uninterrupted sobriety.
- \*\* Desire to help oversee Central Office.
- \*\* Willingness to participate in monthly Intergroup meetings.

#### **Step Two**

Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity."

The moment they read Step Two, most A.A. newcomers are confronted with a dilemma, sometimes a serious one. How often have we heard them cry out, "Look what you people have done to us! You have convinced us that we are alcoholics and that our lives are unmanageable. Having reduced us to a state of absolute helplessness, you now declare that none but a Higher Power can remove our obsession. Some of us won't believe in God, others can't, and still others who do believe

that God exists have no faith whatever He will perform this miracle. Yes, you've got us over the barrel, all right – but where do we go from here?"

#### **Tradition Two**

"For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority – a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern."

Where does A.A. get its direction? Who runs it? This, too, is a puzzler for every friend and newcomer. When told that our Society has no president having authority to govern it, no treasurer who can compel the payment of any dues, no board of directors who can cast an erring member into outer darkness, when indeed no A.A. can give another a directive and enforce obedience, our friends gasp and exclaim, "This simply can't be. There must be an angle somewhere." These practical folk then read Tradition Two, and learn that the sole authority in A.A. is a loving God as He may express Himself in the group conscience. They dubiously ask an experienced A.A. member if this really works. The member, sane to all appearances, immediately answers, "Yes! It definitely does." The friends mutter that this looks vague, nebulous, pretty naïve to them. Then they commence to watch us with speculative yes, pick up a fragment of A.A. history, and soon have the solid facts.

### Trouble: Constructive or Destructive?

"There was a time when we ignored trouble, hoping it would go away. Or, in fear and in depression, we ran from it, but found it was still with us. Often, full of unreason, bitterness, and blame, we fought back. These mistaken attitudes, powered by alcohole, guaranteed our destruction, unless they were altered.

"Then came A.A. Here we learned that trouble was really a fact of life for everybody – a fact that had to be understood and dealt with. Surprisingly, we found that our troubles could, under God's grace, be converted into unimagined blessings.

"Indeed, that was the essence of A.A. itself: trouble accepted, trouble squarely faced with calm courage, trouble lessened and often transcended. This was the A.A. story and we became a part of it. Such demonstrations became our stock in trade for the next suffer." Letter from Bill W., 1966
