The Scoop

AA in the AV

This brief piece marks the beginning of a series of installments about the history of AA in the Antelope Valley. Most of what we have for the earliest days comes from an anonymous writer who did interviews and jotted down notes in 1989.

AA arrived in the AV in 1948 from Los Angeles. The anonymous writer says he could track the various meeting locations based on interviews with five long-timers with a total of 175 years sober in 1989. Eight out of ten meetings were in people's homes.

An AA phone number was in the Antelope Valley phone book since the early 1950s. One man put it there and he paid for it out of pocket until he died in the 1970s.

In 1966 there was a weekly meeting in Palmdale at Carl P.'s house (personal note: Carl P. was Whitey's sponsor and Whitey was my first sponsor). In Lancaster there was one meeting a week at Beech and Lancaster. The Arid Club was started in 1967. Secrecy and word of mouth really made AA stay underground in those days and true 12-step calls were how AA grew, one drunk talking to another.

Future installments of AA in the AV will flesh out more details on these early days in the High Desert. Thank you for reading.

A continuous look at our assets and liabilities, and a real desire to learn and grow by this means, are necessities for us. We alcoholics have learned this the hard way. More experienced people, of course, in all times and places have practiced unsparing self-survey and criticism. For the wise have always known that no one can make much of his life until self-searching becomes a regular habit, until he is able to admit and accept what he finds, and until he patiently and persistently tries to correct what is wrong.

Tradition Ten

"Alcoholics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues; hence the A.A. name ought never be drawn into public controversy."

Never since it began has Alcoholics Anonymous been divided by a major controversial issue. Nor has our Fellowship ever publicly taken sides on any question in an embattled world. This, however, has been no earned virtue. It could almost be said that we were born with it, for, as one oldtimer recently declared, "Practically never have I heard a heated religious, political, or reform argument among A.A. members. So long as we don't argue these matters privately, it's a cinch we never shall publicly."

Excerpts from As Bill Sees It

"You can't make a horse drink water if he still prefers beer or is too crazy to know what he does want. Set a pail of water beside him, tell him how good it is and why, and leave him alone.

"If people really want to get drunk, there is, so far as I know, no way of stopping this – so leave them alone and let them get drunk. But don't exclude them from the water pail, either."

Letter from Bill W., 1942

"Dr. Bob was my constant companion and partner in the great A.A. adventure. As the physician and great human being that he was, he chose work with others as his prime A.A. vocation and achieved a record which, in quantity and in quality, none will ever surpass. Assisted by the incomparable Sister Ignatia at St. Thomas Hospital in Akron, he – without charge—medically treated and spiritually infused five thousand sufferers.

"In all the stress and strain of A.A.'s pioneering time, no hard word ever passed between us. For this, I can thankfully say that the credit was all his."

Letter from Bill W. 1966

"Change is the characteristic of all growth. From drinking to sobriety, from dishonesty to honesty, from conflict to serenity, from hate to love, from childish dependence to adult responsibility – all this an infinitely more represent change for the better

Such changes are accomplished by a belief in and a practice of sound principles. Here we must needs discard bad or ineffective principles in favor of good ones that work. Even good principles can sometimes be displaced by the discovery of still better ones.

"Only God is unchanging; only He has all the truth there is." Letter from Bill W. 1966

"Because of drinking, my friend Henry had lost a high-salaried job. There remained a fine house – with a budget three times his reduced earnings.

"He could have rented the house for enough to carry it. But no! Henry said he knew that God wanted him to live there, and He would see that the costs were paid. So Henry went on running up bills and glowing with faith. Not surprisingly, his creditors finally took over the place.

"Henry can laugh about it now, having learned that God more often helps those who are willing to help themselves."
